

Competition Regulations

1. The Competitions Committee is responsible for framing and interpreting conditions for club competitions. Its decision is binding in all matters relating to competitions.
2. Members are requested to refer to the notice boards for details and rules of competitions, for changes in local rules, dates and format thereof. Emails may also be sent where possible.
3. The Committee reserves the right to postpone, and/or alter dates, conditions and format of competitions when deemed necessary. Members are asked to refer to notice boards and online timesheets for information on such changes. Emails may also be sent where possible.
4. Members playing in Club Competitions must return all cards. (GUI/ILGU directives)
5. Members must inform the Handicap committee when:
 - They equal or better the Standard Scratch in society competitions.
 - They finish in the first three places in golf classics or similar team events.
6. It is the player's responsibility to ensure that:
 - Gross score for each hole is recorded
 - His/her handicap is correct and included on the scorecard
 - The card is signed by both player and marker on completion of the round
7. Club subscriptions must be paid on or before 1st of April in each year to qualify for prizes in any competition or to enter for club Matchplay.
8. Veteran's Prize / Senior's : confined to players 60 years or over. The onus is on veteran's to identify themselves on scorecard.
9. Members are required to "Swipe in " i.e. to enter swipe card in computer prior to playing in 18-hole Singles Competitions.
